



Protection / hygiene concept

We take the following hygienic protective measures to protect students and teachers:

When bringing the children:

1. Your child should wear a face mask when coming and going and can take it off at the workplace.
2. Please only bring your children to the hall in front of the studio.
3. From there, your child should stick to the distance markings on the floor (red and white adhesive strips)



1. The children are then called to the studio one after the other and wash their hands. If a child is on its place, the next child can come in.
2. Siblings can of course do everything together.
3. Please give your child their own smock / apron, the easiest is an old shirt. (In case you forget it: Not bad, we always have freshly washed shirts there)
4. Please do not bring a sick child. Anyone showing symptoms of acute respiratory disease must not enter the studio.

Larger children and adolescents come alone. Please follow the same rules.

When picking up:

- Unfortunately, we currently have to do without you picking up your child in the studio. We send your child outside. We will send a cell phone photo of the work result in the evening or the next day.
- You can wait for the children upstairs in the E1 staircase, which is right next to the studio door. Or the children use the stairwell independently and are expected by you below. It is this exit (unfortunately the door only opens from the inside out)



Staircase E1 / you could e.g. wait here too. Top or bottom.

In the studio:

- We have converted the studio and adapted it to the situation: there is always a distance of at least 1.50 m between the workplaces. In the middle of the tables is a plexiglass pane, which represents a so-called sneeze guard.
- The studio is ventilated every hour and the toilet is cleaned daily.
- We clean and disinfect work tools such as brushes, pottery tools.
- The surfaces of doors, door handles or other objects that are frequently touched by visitors are cleaned several times a day.
- Unfortunately we can no longer "mix" the groups, i.e. it is no longer possible to catch up or swap hours.
